

DAILY ITINERARY ON BEAUTIFUL MACKINAC ISLAND











Day 1 – Monday, May 11 | Travel to the Island & Settle In (D)

Our peaceful island getaway begins as we arrive in Mackinaw City and board the ferry to Mackinac Island—where there are no cars, only the sound of horses and the scent of lilacs in the air. Enjoy the scenic ride across the Straits of Mackinac with views of the iconic **Mackinac Bridge**. Upon arrival, we'll take a horse-drawn taxi to the lovely Mission Point Resort, nestled on the island's **sunrise side**. This historic resort offers beautiful gardens, lakefront paths, and a tranquil setting just a short stroll from downtown. Unpack, relax, and enjoy an included dinner at the resort as we settle into our island home.

Day 2 – Tuesday, May 12 | Carriages, History & Tea Room Views (B, L)
