DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1: Wednesday, June 2, 2027: Arrive today in Fairbanks, in the great state of Alaska, on an adventure that brings together the best of both land and sea. As travelers' arrival times vary greatly, we have no group activities planned during the day. Enjoy dinner on your own tonight.

Day 2: Thursday, June 3, 2027: Step aboard the popular Sternwheeler Discovery, an unforgettable journey showcasing Alaska's diverse culture and rich history. Make stops along the way to meet the people and get a taste of local life. Take a scenic motor coach ride to Denali National Park. Tonight, enjoy a musical performance that tells the story of the first brave men to summit Denali, followed by dinner. (B,L,D)

Day 3: Friday, June 4, 2027: This morning travel deep into Denali National Park on the Tundra Wilderness Tour, which affords the best opportunities to view the region's wildlife. Learn about the history of the park and see why Denali is one of the top three reasons that people visit Alaska. The remainder of the day is at leisure. (B)

Day 4: Saturday, June 5, 2027: Your day begins with a scenic train ride to Talkeetna. Savor every moment inside your luxury domed railcar. View the incredible landscape from glass-ceiling railcars and open-air observation platforms as rail guides provide expert commentary. Check into the iconic Talkeetna Alaskan Lodge, perched on a ridge offering unforgettable views of Denali. (B)

Day 5: Sunday, June 6, 2027: Depart for your ship, stopping en route in Anchorage, Alaska's largest city. Continue with a scenic drive along the Chugach Mountains. Drive along the Turnagain Arm to Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center. Discover where orphaned or injured bears, wolves, porcupines, and moose are cared for in a 200-acre rehabilitation site. Arrive in the port of Whittier where you'll embark on your 7-night Holland America cruise aboard a fabulous floating resort designed to make your stay on board truly memorable. You will be dazzled by the entertainment in the state-of-the-art lounges and a myriad of dining options. While on board, breakfast, lunch, dinner and nightly entertainment are included (B,L,D)

Day 6: Monday, June 7, 2027: When conditions allow, your ship cruises up to the mammoth Hubbard Glacier, one of the Alaska's largest glaciers. Have your camera ready and take in the natural beauty of the glacier's stunning surface. (B,L,D)

Day 7: Tuesday, June 8, 2026: Cruise into Glacier Bay, a spectacular national park and preserve that is a treasure trove of tidewater glaciers and scenic coastal islands. Its rich world of marine life and large concentration of tidewater glaciers is Alaska at its best. (B,L,D)

Day 8: Wednesday, June 9, 2027: Skagway is your first port of call where you have the entire day to explore its gold rush history and see why it is called the "Garden City of Alaska." The town is small but big on adventure with many things to see and do! (B,L,D)

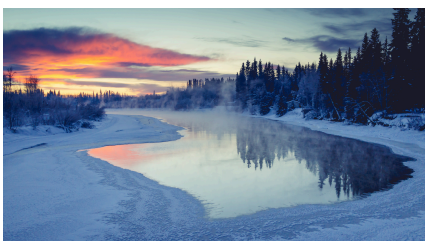
Day 9: Thursday, June 10, 2027: From massive scenic mountains to historic buildings, there is so much to explore in Alaska's capital city of Juneau. (B,L,D)

Day 10: Friday, June 11, 2027: Your port of call today is Ketchikan, known as the "Salmon Capital of the World" and the "City of Totems." Located on the tranquil Revillagigedo Island, Ketchikan is home to the world's largest collection of totem poles. (B,L,D)

Day 11: Saturday June 12, 2027: A wonderful day of sightseeing awaits as your ship sails along the amazing Inside Passage. (B,L,D)

Day 12: Sunday, June 13, 2027: Your cruise ends this morning in the vibrant Canadian city of Vancouver. Ascend Grouse Mountain on an enclosed gondola and take in panoramic views while you enjoy lunch on the peak of Vancouver. Join a private ranger-led tour to meet two grizzly bears that were rescued in 2001. Later, stop at beautiful Stanley Park, Canada's renowned urban rainforest. Follow the park's famous seawall and encounter mountain views along trails, beaches, historical landmarks, and colorful gardens. (B,L)

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Identification: Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Your passport must be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. We recommend travelers take a photocopy of their passport. It should be packed separately from your actual passport. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

Activity Level: The overall activity level of this tour is a level 1. This means you're a leisurely traveler. You typically take it easy and discover the energy of a new place by people-watching or soaking in the atmosphere at a local cafe. You can climb at least one flight of stairs, board a coach, and walk unassisted at a relaxed pace for up to 60 minutes without difficulty. You can easily handle altitudes up to 5,000 feet.

Solo Travelers: Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Airfare and Transfers: To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave to pre-scheduled times. Most flights arrive into Fairbanks very late at night followed by an early morning the next day. For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties. Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Cruise Information: Order of ports may be changed by the cruise line. The following categories will be utilized when confirming cabin assignments: Inside Category: L, Oceanview Category: F, Veranda Category: VD. Cruise ships have a limited quantity of cabins available in each cabin category. We will make every effort to accommodate your cabin category preference at the time of booking. If the cabin category preferred is not available at the time of booking, the next closest category available will be offered and a surcharge may apply.

Gratuities: Prepaid tipping is not available on land tours. Therefore, payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of this tour. Onboard gratuities are not included in the price of your tour. For your convenience, Holland America Cruise Lines automatically applies a \$17.00 per traveler, per day service charge to your shipboard account. If you upgrade to a suite, the gratuities increase to \$18.50 per traveler, per day. This service charge covers all onboard service personnel, so no additional tipping is necessary. Please be aware that the service charge can be adjusted at guest services onboard the ship if you feel the service did not meet your expectations. Separately, an 18% gratuity is added for bar drinks and spa services. You are required to settle your shipboard account before disembarkation.

Miscellaneous: If you require special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of your reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention. Please note that your hotel in Vancouver is close to the airport, allowing for a convenient and comfortable departure. You will travel on motorcoach days with an average of 37 people & a maximum of 44.
