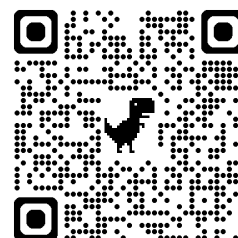

DAILY ITINERARY



Day 1: Monday, October 18, 2027 Overnight Flight - You're on your way to Greece - where Mediterranean sunshine and bright blue waters meet eons of creative ingenuity and an everlasting legacy. Feel the energy of the past and allow the ocean breeze to ruffle your hair - this is the picture-perfect getaway you've always dreamt of.



Day 2: Tuesday, October 19, 2027 Athens - Begin your journey in Athens, the immortalized capital of Greece. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today. Spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. Tonight, meet your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner of local cuisine and wine. (D)



Day 3: Wednesday, October 20, 2027 Athens - See the best of Athens with a local expert who highlights the city's ancient roots on a comprehensive panoramic tour. Make your way along the world-renowned monuments, including the Temple of Zeus, the Parliament, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, and the Olympic Stadium. Step into the past on a tour of the legendary Acropolis, an ancient complex housing a collection of temples. Admire the breathtaking view of the city below and discover the country's beloved icon: the illustrious Parthenon. Make the most of an afternoon and evening at leisure. (B)



Day 4: Thursday, October 21, 2027 Athens - Mykonos - Start your day aboard a sleek, high-speed boat ride to Mykonos, an island paradise surrounded by the crystal-clear Aegean Sea. Start your island stay with an exploration of Chora, Mykonos' Old Town, where you discover its winding lanes independently. In the afternoon, check in to your hotel for a relaxing 3-night stay. From sandy beaches and seaside cafes to street musicians and a never-ending nightlife scene, Mykonos offers limitless opportunities to kick back and enjoy the island's irresistible lifestyle. Day 5: Friday, October 22, 2027 Mykonos - The day is yours! Perhaps you will head down to the beach to soak up some sun, sip a cup of coffee on the waterfront promenade, or explore the town's winding streets as you weave in and out of whitewashed buildings. Or, you may join an optional excursion to the colorful village of Ano Mera, followed by a cheese tasting experience with a local farmer, exploring the true flavors of Mykonos. (B)



Day 6: Saturday, October 23, 2027 Mykonos - This morning, step into the past on a half-day optional excursion to the isle of Delos* taking you to the fabled birthplace of the Greek Gods Apollo and Artemis. After, it's your choice! Relax on one of the island's pristine beaches, perfect for sunbathing, swimming, and enjoying the beach bars - OR- explore Lena's House Museum, a 19th century home filled with authentic furnishings and artifacts that showcase the rich Cycladic culture and history. Enjoy the evening on your own. (B)



Day 7: Sunday, October 24, 2027 Mykonos - Oia - Santorini - Your journey continues to Santorini, the Eden-like island where bluedomed rooftops and gentle ocean waves complement the bright white buildings and rocky hillsides. On arrival, head through a landscape of vineyards and volcanic cliffs to Oia, a seaside village with the island's best viewpoints. A picturesque landscape and iconic destination, Santorini's charms reveal themselves during your 3-night stay. (B, D)

Day 8: Monday, October 25, 2027 Santorini - Akrotiri - Santorini - Uncover the past at Akrotiri, an ancient city buried and preserved in volcanic ash that is commonly referred to as the "Minoan Pompeii." Take a peek into the 15th century BC and explore the town. Next, enjoy a private visit to a local winery and taste the famous wines of Santorini along with a light lunch of local snacks. The rest of the afternoon is yours to relax and explore more of this Mediterranean gem. (B, L)

Day 9: Tuesday, October 26, 2027 Santorini - Make the most of a day at leisure. Relax, shop in the island's charming town center, or even visit a local museum. Or, join our full day Island Hopping and Cruise** optional excursion for a visit to some of the magical islets that surround Santorini before enjoying dinner on board. (B)

Day 10 Wednesday, October 27, 2027 Santorini -Athens - Depart the islands and fly back to Athens for your final night in Greece. Toast to the end of your sun-filled getaway at a local taverna in the city's historic district, with traditional Greek entertainment. (B,D)

Day 11 Thursday, October 28, 2027 Athens - Tour Ends - Wish the Mediterranean goodbye as your tour draws to a close today. (B)

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Identification: Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department for the latest details about passports and visa requirements. **IMPORTANT:** We recommend that travelers take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact. Collette will provide all necessary information, updates, and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), if required, approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure. ETIAS visa waiver requirements are anticipated to begin during the last quarter of 2026, for a fee, when visiting a Schengen Area Country. Activity Level: The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices. Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44). Luggage handling is not available when getting on and off the public ferries between Athens, Mykonos, and Santorini. You will need to carry your own luggage for approximately 200 feet each way. As the ferry is the main connection between the mainland and several islands, you can expect large crowds and personnel directing travelers to their destinations with a very quick turnaround. For those on the Ancient Delos optional tour, this will require a flat walk of up to 3 hours and 1 mile in the sun (weather-dependent), with no shaded areas. If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention. In order to access the Acropolis archeological site, you will be required to climb about 50-60 steep, uneven steps and walk over rugged terrain with loose stones and without railings.

Solo Travelers: Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability

Airfare and Transfers: To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times. For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties. Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions. Internal flights are required in order to participate in this tour and are included in the final price, quoted at time of booking.

Gratuities: Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel, and housekeepers should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Miscellaneous: If you require special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of your reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention. Due to ferry schedules on some departures, you may be required to depart the hotel as early as 5:30 a.m. Should this be the case, a boxed breakfast will be provided in place of the regular hotel breakfast. Due to a limited number of tickets for the Acropolis, travelers who book within 60 days of departure may be waitlisted until tickets can be confirmed.

*The "Ancient Delos: Apollo's Sacred Island" option must be purchased at least 10 days prior to departure.
