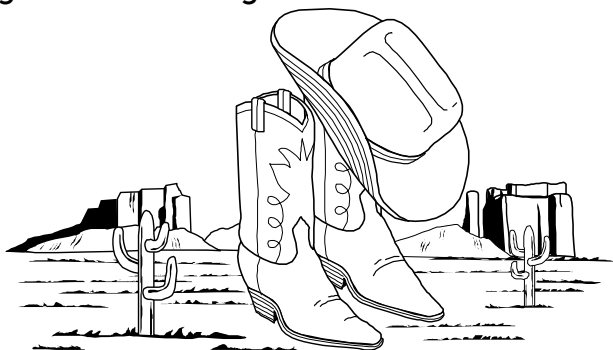
## Itinerary:

Wednesday, April 21, 2010

Depart early for Texas on a flight at 9:00 am and arrive about 11:00 am. Friday, April 23

When you arrive at the Stockyards, enjoy the western shops, explore the **Texas Cowboy Hall of Fame**, make a visit to **Billy Bob's**, or just enjoy a leisurely afternoon in the old west. Then watch as there is a live **Longhorn Cattle Drive** along Exchange Avenue. As the day winds down head back to the hotel and tonight enjoy a **Murder Mystery Dinner Theatre** at the hotel.
