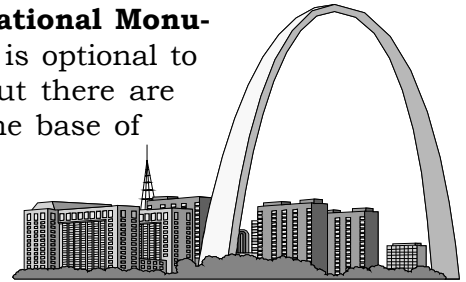

Day 1 June 7, 2010 Monday
Travel to St. Louis

Day 3 June 9, 2010 Wednesday

Upon arrival visit the Thorncrown Chapel containing 425 windows and 6,000 square feet of glass, it is of simple design with majestic beauty. Then visit the quaint area of **Downtown Eureka Springs**. The entire downtown with its well preserved Victorian architecture is listed in the National Register of Historic Places. Just outside of town is America's #1 outdoor drama, **The Great Passion Play**. Prior to the show, visit the Campus including seeing Christ of the Ozarks, a museum, a potter working at a wheel, and myriads of other things. The unforgettable and inspiring performance has been enjoyed by more than 7 million people from all over the world for 35 years. Arrive back in Branson very late. **optional** if you do not want to go to Passion Play...Dinner will be in town and you can see the violin playing Japanese, **Shoji Tabuchi**, by far the most popular show in Branson.
