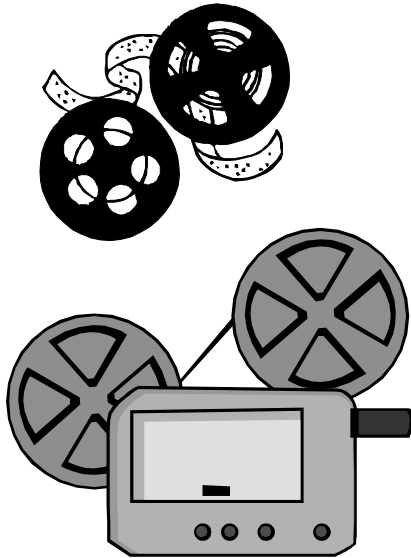

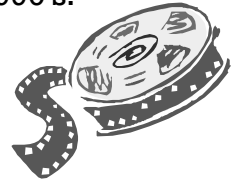

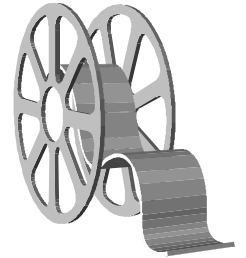


Check into your hotel, freshen up and end the day at the King's Warf Restaurant and Marriott Theatre for dinner and your theatre experience. The Drowsy Chaperone is playing. This is based on a beloved movie. Drift off to sleep with visions of search lights, red carpets and paparazzi.

Thursday, June 17, 2010

Woodstock, Illinois was the movie set for "Groundhog Day." Take a walking tour of Groundhog sites on the Historic Woodstock Square. Tour the Woodstock Opera House which became the Pennsylvania Hotel in the movie. Have lunch on your own in the Square and leisurely discover Woodstock's charm. Is that Ned Ryerson, rounding the bend? Bing! Do you hear faint sounds of the Pennsylvania Polka? Any time you come whether it be Feb. 2 or not, you will want to relive this town over and over again.

Pay a visit to the Illinois Railway Museum with an emphasis on Hollywood Connection...where do Hollywood studios find the vintage rail equipment that appears in period films? In "A League of their Own" moviegoers were transported back to 1942 as they watched the sleek silver Zephyr and also the museum depot and tower buildings. "The Babe" scenes were shot here using the 1859 horse-drawn car as Chicago stood in for Baltimore. "The Dollmaker," "Groundhog Day," "Under the Biltmore Clock," "Ali" and other productions used IRM equipment. See all these on display at IRM! Board the motorcoach for a delightful dinner at Port Edwards Restaurant, one of America's most unusual restaurants by the AAA Club. It is a cozy meeting place overlooking the Fox River. Return to the hotel for a good night's rest.

Arise this morning to continue your movie adventure. Depart with a step on guide and travel along Lake Michigan's North Shore to Chicago. "Hollywood on the Lake" is the essence of the tour.
