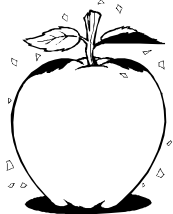

# ITINERARY FOR NEW YORK CITY

## Day 1: Saturday, August 21, 2010

Begin today from the downriver area and travel all day to Pennsylvania's, **Pocono Mountains**, just a couple of hours from NYC. ## Day 3: Monday, August 23, 2010

This morning choose between a hop on hop off city tour or a shopping tour finding the best deals and bargains from Armani to Zegna and more. End at Central Park with a late lunch at **Tavern on the Green**. As many of you know, Tavern on the Green closed with the promise of opening again in 2010. If this is not available, we will find another restaurant. Spend the rest of the day at Central Park or the shopping district, or where ever you like. Overnight again in the Times Square District. **Perhaps** you will want to go to the Empire State Building, or the Top of the Rock. Both are within walking distance of our hotel located at Times Square. Your tour manager will help you select and direct you to your selections. Perhaps take in a Broadway or Off Broadway show tonight. **(L)**

## Day 4: Tuesday, August 24, 2010

**Free time**...spend your entire day doing just what you want to do. You have seen a lot of New York City with a local guide. You have heard about many areas and museums and all types of entertainment including places to shop. Today pursue your own interests. Take a Taxi, a subway, or go on foot to look at something more in depth. What is it you have always wanted to see in New York City? Do it today. Don't forget about South Street Seaport. And, what about the Navy Ship, Intrepid. An optional show will be suggested about 45 days prior to departure. You will have the opportunity to choose it, or continue into the evening on your own. Mid-afternoon gather together in New Jersey for our motor coach ride back to the Pocono's and our farewell dinner tonight. **(D)**
